Make A Crematorium Funeral Special

- 1 Decorate the ceremony hall, with flowers, plants, candles, objects, coloured materials and photographs.
- 2 Let family and friends carry the coffin in – it is such an honour and heartfelt thing to do.
- 3 Place the coffin on trestles closer to the family for a more intimate feel if there is space for this.
- 4 Choose a celebrant or minister who will spend time finding out about the person who has died and help you to devise a ceremony which reflects their views and beliefs.
- 5 Choose whatever words and music you like – they do not have to be funeral. Live music is always special.
- 6 Crematoria are all different and you may have a choice of more than one. Choose the one that feels better, or has a longer ceremony time.
- 7 Consider holding the main funeral ceremony elsewhere, in our beautiful ceremony hall, at home, a village hall or elsewhere.
- 8 Book a double time at the crematorium if you want to have a longer ceremony, so you don't feel rushed.
- 9 Make time during the ceremony to place single stems or posies on the coffin if there are not too many people.
- 10 Have time for quiet reflection with beautiful music. A sense of spaciousness in the ceremony is better than overcrowding it.
